I would like to invite you to the **Incoming Ninth Grade Family Night** program that will take place at Lake Park's East Campus on **Wednesday, January 20.** This event represents your first opportunity to be directly involved in developing your student's high school educational plan. Please make arrangements to attend.

The program is designed to benefit students <u>and</u> parents. To accommodate all attendees, the starting times are staggered. See the start time for each middle school below. The program in the auditorium will include: a) review of placement information; b) interpretation of Explore test results; and c) explanation of elective course offerings. An open house in the cafeteria provides families with an opportunity to meet faculty from each department and ask questions of counselors.

During January, Lake Park counselors will visit each middle school to preview and discuss the *Academic Planning Guide*, which is available to families on the district website homepage at <u>www.lphs.org</u>. The *Academic Planning Guide* is an important educational planning resource for you and your student. Posting an electronic version of this guide allows Lake Park to provide families with the most current information. A printed copy is available upon request if you do not have access to viewing online. After the Family Night Program, you will have all the information needed to complete the registration and course selection process.

I encourage you and your student to attend this orientation program. Our next opportunity to meet will be in the spring when programs are scheduled for parents and incoming ninth grade students.
