
Action Items

Administrative Appointments for 2016-2017

The Board of Education outlined the future direction of the district, effective for the 2016-2017 school year, by unanimously approving:

- appointment of Jim Roberts as the Assistant Superintendent for Curriculum and Instruction
- appointment of John Gouriotis as Principal
- appointment of Tim Noverini as Associate Principal of West Campus

The vacancy of Associate Principal for East Campus has been posted and will be hired internally. A hiring recommendation is expected at the September 28, 2015 Board meeting.



Superintendent's Report

Dr. Panega provided an update about a special meeting of the Board of Education, commended the retiring administrators for their leadership and highlighted the hiring decisions for 2016-2017.

- The Board of Education conducted a special meeting to review the district's capital improvement plan, the feasibility of a pool within the existing fieldhouse, the feasibility of a fieldhouse and financial options to consider these improvements. Robert Lewis of PMA Securities provided an overview of school funding for bonds and current bonds.
 - Board members will continue this discussion during a Finance Committee meeting on Aug. 31 and another special meeting of the Board on Sept. 14 from 5 to 7 p.m. at East Campus.
- At the conclusion of this school year, Lake Park will sadly lose two valuable administrators to retirement: Janet Constien, West Campus Principal; and Bob Ungaro, Director of Operations and Maintenance. The timing was right to organizationally review district and campus administrative structures, and move in the direction of establishing a one principal model.

Dr. Panega commended the Board for their research, discussions and support of the emerging leadership structure. She is excited about the future and looks forward to embracing a year of transition that focuses on uniting the campuses: "We Are One!"
