### COURSE OVERVIEW:

Drawing 2 is an advanced studio level course that builds on the outcomes of Drawing 1 class and introduces students to a wider range of media exploration. Wet and dry media are used. Techniques in pen and ink, silverpoint, chalk, charcoal and pastel are introduced.
