

GERMAN 2  
GRADES 9-12  
(2 Semesters – Prerequisite: German 1)

COURSE OVERVIEW:

This class builds on the foundations of German 1-2, expanding verb tenses and vocabulary, while continuing to stress oral proficiency. Reading and writing levels increase; compositions and other writings also take place on the word processor (in German).

UNITS OF INSTRUCTION:

- REVIEW - Interviews, present perfect, possessive pronouns, parts of the body, clothing, musical instruments, *dative* case (Indirect object)
  
- UNIT I - Airport & Travel: Luggage and Airport Vocabulary: reflexive construction, indirect and direct object pronouns and order, present perfect continued with imperfect
  
- UNIT II - Letters & Post: Addressing, Sending and Post Office Vocabulary: imperfect with present perfect, modal auxiliaries, gerund forms
  
- UNIT III - Vacations & Travel Bureau: Countries, Nationalities, Languages and Professions: genitive case and *dies-/welch-/jed-* as determiners
  
- UNIT IV - Food, Rooms, & Furniture: baking, *gern* and *lieber*, diorama project
  
- UNIT V - Restaurant (Food), Dishes, Silverware, Menu: video project, adjective declension with *ein* words
  
- UNIT VI - Food, Groceries, Stores, Fruits & Vegetables: video project, adjective declension with *der* words
  
- UNIT VII - Swimming Pool, Holidays & Greetings: *Karneval*, Akkusative/*Dative* prepositions; *da-/dahin*; *da-/wo-* compounds
  
- UNIT VIII - Leisure Activities, Boat, Zoo Trips: past perfect tense, coordinating and subordinating conjunctions
  
- UNIT IX - Health, Ailments, Medicine: *Dative* verbs, verb-preposition combinations, relative pronouns
