On behalf of the entire faculty and staff of Lake Park High School, we hope that you are having an enjoyable summer and we look forward to seeing you in August. The 2010-11 school year promises to be a challenging, rewarding, and exciting experience. We cannot wait to greet the class of 2014! Read on to learn about our ***newly revised*** orientation program.

The orientation program begins promptly at 8 AM on August 9 and 10. We suggest that you ride the bus to school so that you become familiar with our transportation process. **Your class schedule and bus routes will be mailed to East Campus students during the first week of August.** If you receive a ride to school, then be sure to arrive no later than 7:45 AM. Read the enclosed sheet (green) about drop-off and pick-up locations. During the orientation, you will learn about the wide variety of teams, clubs, and activities that are available to students. You will also hear about the academic support opportunities that we provide, our behavior expectations, and important information that you will need to know to be successful at Lake Park.

Additionally, students will receive their textbooks, ID picture, Lancer Log, PE uniform, lock, and other materials at orientation. ***Your ID picture is also used as your yearbook picture, so please dress appropriately.*** Be sure to bring your schedule to the orientation program as you will have a chance to visit your classrooms and locker during the orientation.

If you have not enrolled in school, then you will not receive your schedule. Therefore, it is very important that students are enrolled as soon as possible. That said, students may still participate in the orientation program; however, they will not receive their materials. Contact the Student Services office (630) 295-5231 for bus route information for the orientation programs. **Read on to learn about the specific date that you should attend for orientation.**

ORIENTATION – DATES AND TIMES

- August 9 (Last Name A-K) Orientation program begins promptly at 8 AM (Ends approximately 11 AM)
- August 10 (Last Name L-Z) Orientation program begins promptly at 8 AM (Ends approximately 11 AM)
- Bus transportation is provided. Be at your bus stop at the scheduled time. Remember, your bus schedule will be mailed to you with your class schedule during the first week of August.

MAKE-UP ORIENTATION

- Attendance at orientation is highly recommended. If you cannot attend on your assigned date, then make-up orientation takes place on August 11 (4 – 7 PM). **No bus transportation is provided.** If you cannot attend any of the orientation dates, then you will receive your materials on the first day of school. Keep in mind, this will delay your entry into your classes.

Finally, you and your family are invited to attend our Freshmen Family BBQ on **Thursday, August 12.** The BBQ begins at 6 PM and the program starts at 7 PM. Come enjoy food, games, a spirit rally, live music, DJ-dance for the students, and parent program. Festivities conclude by 9 PM.
