Taylor Chester



Classroom Activities

Since the beginning of the school year, students have been exploring new concepts, trying new activities, and learning about their classmates and teachers. Here are some examples of classroom happenings:

• Tom Kaberna and Gina Ratner – In our Algebra 1 (double period) class, students got to know each other during the first week of school.



 Paula Williams - My period 6 and period 8 Honors Algebra 2 students used their Chromebooks to complete a student-centered warm-up on Khan Academy. While I circulated to check off homework at the beginning of class, they viewed a short Khan Academy video on Solving Absolute Value Equations then practiced related problems. They also watched a video on Solving Absolute Value Inequalities and practiced related problems. This was in lieu of the traditional worksheet-type warm-up, to improve student performance on difficult concepts from the summer packet.







- John Nellessen and Ben Bishop We are integrating MyMathLab into Finite Math this year. It is an online, all-in-one math interface that colleges/universities (the University of Illinois, College of DuPage, and more) use for the online sections of their math courses. It will be a great opportunity for seniors to see what they will use in college if they enroll in an online section of a math course. This prepares the course for the 1:1 Chromebook integration with the seniors in 2019-2020. We also hope to use MyMathLab in a dual credit Finite course in the future.
