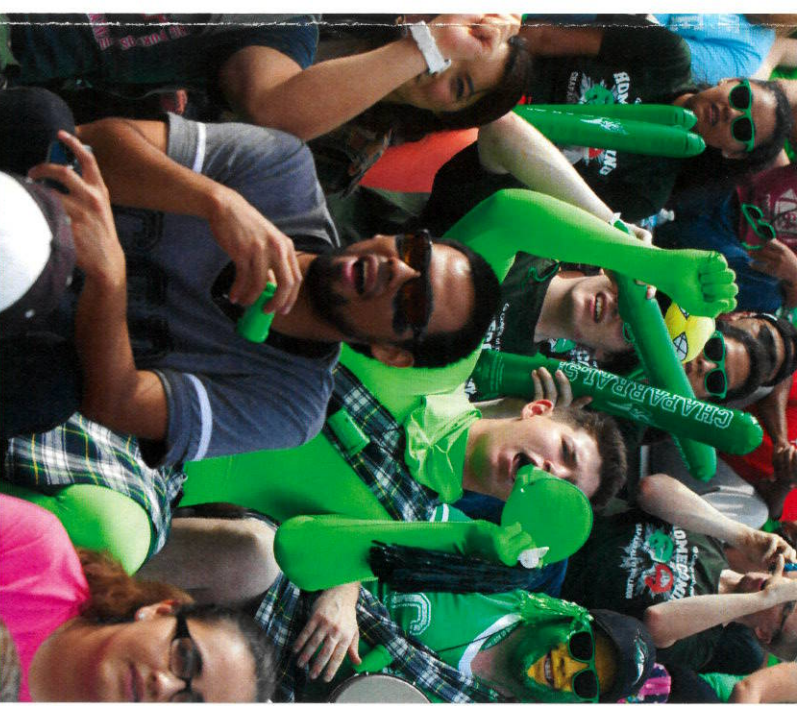

STEPS TO ENROLLMENT

- ☐ Meet with an Admissions Representative or Attend an On-Campus Event
Visit cod.edu/contact_admissions to meet or contact your admissions representative. Visit cod.edu/visit to learn more about upcoming Admissions and Outreach events.
- ☐ Create a Profile and Submit the General Admissions Application
To create your profile and complete your application, visit admissions.cod.edu.
- ☐ Create Your myACCESS Account
Your COD ID number will be provided to you in your welcome email. Go to myaccess.cod.edu and use your COD ID number to create your myACCESS account.
- ☐ Set Up Your @dupage.edu Email Account
Your [@dupage.edu](mailto:dupage.edu) email will be generated once you set up your myACCESS account. All official emails from COD will be sent to your @dupage.edu email. To setup your email, visit cod.edu/email.
- ☐ Learn More About Financial Aid and Explore Payment Plan Options
Visit Financial Aid Self Service, available in myACCESS, to start the financial aid process. Financial aid may include grants, scholarships, military benefits, student loans or student employment.

- ☐ Submit Transcripts and Test Scores
Prior to taking placement tests, you should submit high school and/or college transcripts, ACT, SAT, AP or CLEP scores to verify proof of course prerequisites. Official documentation can be sent to the Office of Student Records.
- ☐ Complete Placement Tests (if applicable)
It is highly recommended that you complete the Reading, Writing, EL/S/ESL, and/or Math Placement Tests prior to your first semester.

- ☐ Attend New Student Advising and Registration (NSAR) Session
To schedule your NSAR appointment to meet with a counselor or advisor from Counseling, Advising and Transfer Services, call Campus Central at (630) 942-3000. You must complete any necessary course prerequisites. Learn more at cod.edu/nsar.
- ☐ Meet with the Office of Access and Accommodations (if applicable)
If you need accommodations for a disability, visit cod.edu/access.
- ☐ Register for Classes
To register for classes, login to myACCESS and review your educational plan on Student Planning.
- ☐ Pay for Classes or Set Up a Payment Plan
Students using financial aid or military benefits may be eligible for the Deferred Payment Plan. To pay for classes or set up a payment plan, login to your myACCESS account and review the "Student Payment Information" section.
- ☐ Meet with Your Navigator
Visit the Center for Student Success to connect with your navigator.
- ☐ Attend New Student Orientation (NSO)
New Student Orientation is available every fall and spring semester. Kick off the school year right and get to know other COD Chaparrals! Visit cod.edu/nso for more information.
