PSAT

THE PRELIMINARY SCHOLASTIC APTITUDE TEST

- ⦿ **All juniors test this year**
- ⦿ **October 19th at WC**
 - ⦿ No cost or need to register
 - ⦿ A practice SAT and is NOT used for college admissions
 - ⦿ The results ARE used for National Merit Scholarship consideration

SAT

- All juniors take on April 5, 2017
 - LP signs you up, no cost
- SAT prep class registration in November. Classes will start in January. (*More information to follow.*)
- Free online SAT prep through KAPLAN Test Prep Visit kaplanatschool.com/lakepark
- It is recommended that junior students consider registering for a National SAT test date in addition to April test at Lake Park

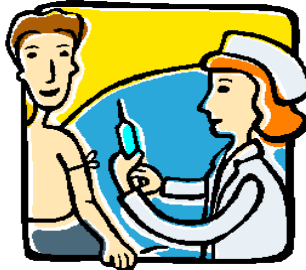
