
#### Fall Athletic Student Recognition

Director of Athletics Pete Schauer presented a co-curricular report that highlighted student participation as well as recognized individual and team accomplishments. This fall, 621 Lake Park students competed in athletic offerings, representing an increase in participation from last year by over 10 percent.

Of the qualifying 349 eligible sophomore, junior, and senior athletes, 145 achieved the prestigious DuPage Valley Conference (DVC) Academic All Conference Status by maintaining an overall GPA of 4.0 or higher. The average GPA of all qualifying sophomore, junior, and senior athletes who have completed at least 2 semesters of course work is better than 4.3 on a 5.0 scale. Furthermore, nine fall programs achieved the IHSA All Academic Team Award by team members collectively earning an average GPA of 4.0 or higher. Girls Cross Country lead the way with an impressive team GPA of 4.94.

## **Action Items**

## **Purchase of New Grounds Equipment**

The Board approved the purchase of a Polaris Brutus Utility Vehicle with cab, heater and diesel engine, including a 66" snow brush, 60" snow blower and 72" mower to replace four existing pieces of grounds equipment that are 15 years or older.

## **3-Year Contract Signed for Graduation**

Based on positive feedback from staff, students and parents, the Board approved the administrative recommendation to sign a 3-year contract with the Sears Centre Arena in Hoffman Estates as the venue for commencement. This agreement secures graduation dates and established fees for: 2016 \$33.785.73

## **Reclassification of Director of Athletics**

Over the past two months, the Administration presented information to the Board in closed session related to a plan to reclassify the Director of Athletics position into the Assistant Principal for Athletics and Alternative Education effective January 1, 2016. In this expanded role, the Assistant Principal for Athletics and Alternative Education will oversee athletics and assume oversight of the alternative education program, including responsibilities related to the support of curriculum development and instructional practices for this program.

### **Reclassification of Director of Activities**

Over the past two months, the Administration presented information to the Board in closed session related to a plan to reclassify the Director of Activities position into the Assistant Principal for Instructional Innovation and Activities effective January 1, 2016. In this expanded role, the Assistant Principal for Instructional Innovation and Activities will oversee activities and take on responsibilities related to the support of instructional technology and coaching, 1:1 implementation and data driven decision making.

Given the volume of responsibilities included in the expansion and reclassification of this position, Board members approved the recommendation to create a 0.4 FTE (half will come from a 0.2 instructional release and the other half will come from a 0.2 supervisory release) Assistant Activities Director position effective January 1, 2016.

The new Assistant Activities Director will assist with the planning, organizing and supervisory responsibilities that relate to student activities.

# Superintendent's Report

Dr. Panega distributed the Illinois School Report Card, previewed final exams and wished everyone a very happy holiday season!

- Board members received a hard copy of the State of Illinois School Report Card. A summary highlighting student achievement and the PARCC results (Partnership for Assessment of Readiness for College and Careers) will be presented during the January 25, 2016 meeting.
- This week concludes the end of a very busy and successful first semester. The revised format and schedule for final exams will be introduced for the first time on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday. A staff survey will be administered to capture feedback about the end of semester experience.
