## Discussion Items

### Agreement for Usage of Medinah Christian Church Parking Lot

Assistant Superintendent for Business Services Dr. Jeff O'Connell reviewed the terms of a license agreement with Medinah Christian Church for use of their parking lot. The proposed 3-year agreement contains an annual fee of \$6,000 as well as a one-time \$4,187 payment for damage due to bus traffic from past usage. The parking lot can only be utilized as a bus drop-off zone for visiting schools. This new practice will be communicated via athletics. Spectators can utilize the lot for parking.

### West Campus Weight Room Bids

Dr. O'Connell reviewed results of the West Campus weight room bid opening from May 18. The proposal for renovation includes new rubber flooring, ceiling tile, painting and removal of the cage. The project is expected to commence in mid-July.

## Action Items

### New Course Proposal

The Board approved Curriculum Council's recommendation of a new course proposal for implementation in the 2018-19 school year.

- ♦ **Civil Engineering and Architecture** - a one-year elective course offered at West Campus for students in Grades 11 and 12.

### Pepsi Beverages Company Contract

As discussed last month, the Board approved a 5-year agreement with Pepsi Beverages Company for a revised benchmark of 20,000 cases. The terms also include an annual \$8,000 sponsorship from Pepsi and rebates for food service and Booster sales.

### Building Automation System

As discussed last month, the Board approved a 5-year agreement with Siemens to replace the panels associated with the Building Automation System. The allocation of \$100,000 or \$50,000 per campus per year develops a phase-in plan and also establishes a replacement cycle so that the equipment need not be replaced at one time.

### License Agreement for Medinah Christian Church Parking Lot

As discussed earlier on the agenda, the Board approved the 3-year agreement with Medinah Christian Church to utilize their parking lot for convenient patron access to the stadium and fields during school events. The agreement lasts from August 1, 2016 to August 1, 2019.

### West Campus Weight Room Bids

As discussed earlier on the agenda, the Board approved bid results for Mondo rubber flooring and ceiling grid and tile as part of the West Campus weight room renovation project. Bids for painting and wire mesh partitions were rejected and will be re-bid at another time.
