2017-18 Student Registration Fees

The recommended student fees for the 2017-18 school year were presented for discussion. The increase is aligned to the December 2015 Consumer Price Index (CPI) of 0.7 percent. Administration is recommending an increase for the following categories:

Social Emotional Learning (SEL): Student Stress Survey Data

Director of Pupil Personnel Services (PPS) Mitch Berenson and East Campus Social Worker Joel Zedrow [presented the results](#) of the student stress survey administered in December 2016.

They also cited national studies that show stress is a rising trend, which affects all schools and communities.

Lake Park's SEL committee has analyzed the data gathered from the self-assessment and is currently developing lessons to implement in the months of April and May. These lessons will primarily focus on students' ability to identify sources of stress, their responses to stressful situations, and healthy ways to deal with stress.

Board Policy Manual: Section 5 and Section 7 Revisions

Lake Park administrators and legal counsel are currently in the process of reviewing and updating the Board Policy Manual. Section 5 (Personnel) and Section 7 (Students) were presented for first reading and discussion.

Action Items

Rates for Legal Services

Lake Park received notice from legal counsel Robbins Schwartz that the ranges of their hourly rates have increased by \$5 an hour, effective January 1, 2017. The Board approved payment of their hourly rate increases to \$245.

Intergovernmental Agreement—East Campus Usage

The Bloomingdale Park District approached Lake Park about utilizing East Campus for Adult Continuing Education classes. To formalize the use of District facilities (no facility use fees), Robbins Schwartz and legal counsel representing the Bloomingdale Park District recommended executing an intergovernmental agreement between agencies. The Board approved the agreement outlining the terms of use.

Resolution Board Policy 2.125

Revisions to Board Policy 2.125 (Board Member Compensation; Expenses) were enacted through approval of PA-099-604, Local Government Travel Expense Control Act, which became effective January 1, 2017. This policy outlines specifics relating to board and administrator travel expense reimbursements. At the recommendation of District legal counsel, the Board adopted and approved the resolution for Board Policy 2.125.

Board Policy Manual Revisions

The Board Policy Manual Revisions for Section 2 (Board of Education) and Section 6 (Instruction) was approved by the Board.

Superintendent's Report

Dr. Lynn Panega highlighted recent student and staff recognition and previewed the academic week ahead.

- Congratulations to Lake Park's 10-member Rube Goldberg team, sponsored by faculty member Jimmy Kryger, for earning a back-to-back State Championship title and advancing to National competition in Ohio.
- The varsity boys basketball team advanced in the first round of IHSA competition at the Prospect Regional by beating Elk Grove High School. The Lancers take on Buffalo Grove on **Wednesday, March 1** with tip-off at 7:30 p.m.
- Spring semester parent teacher conferences will be conducted on **Thursday, March 2** from 5:30 to 8:30 p.m. at both campuses. The students will follow a SMART Day schedule.
- On **Friday, March 3**, faculty will participate in the annual County-wide Institute Day with professional development opportunities available on-campus and throughout DuPage County. Lake Park will host the NDSEC Connections Conference, with expected attendance of more than 800 educators attending sessions districtwide. Lake Park campuses and offices will be closed on **Monday, March 6** in observance of Casimir Pulaski Day.

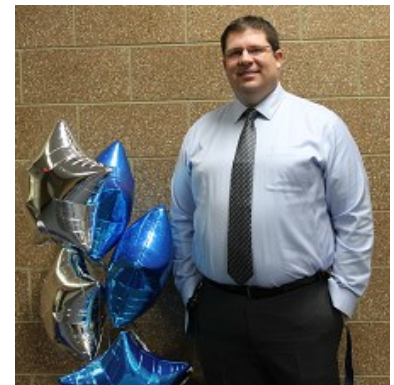
