Action Items

Memorandum of Agreement

The Board of Education approved a Memorandum of Agreement for a former Lake Park High School staff member. The agreement, which provided a reimbursement for the optional service credit purchased before retiring from Lake Park, resulted in significant savings for the District. This individual entered into an agreement with the Teachers' Retirement System to purchase additional service credit to reduce future employment cost to the District.

The parties acknowledged and agreed that the District's agreement to pay Teacher a post-retirement payment is based solely on the specific circumstances involved in Teacher's situation. The parties further agreed that this Memorandum of Agreement shall not bind them with respect to the parties' respective treatment of any future requests by teachers for post-retirement payments.

Fiscal Year Budget for 2017-2018

Assistant Superintendent for Business Services Jeff O'Connell reviewed information about the District's tentative budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2017 and ending June 30, 2018. Public notice was provided that the tentative budget was available for public viewing at the Administration Center for the past 30 days, and a public hearing was conducted at the beginning of the meeting.

Dr. O'Connell presented the formal recommendation for the 2017-2018 fiscal year budget as an action item on the agenda. He reviewed the assumptions used to create the budget, including the 0.7 percent Consumer Price Index, general state aid allocations, PPO/HMO insurance premiums and other factors like Technology Center of DuPage tuition and special education out-of-district placements.

Committed to maintaining a balanced budget, the Lake Park Board of Education approved the final FY18 budget.

Dr. Panega promoted an upcoming community program sponsored by <u>The League of Women Voters of Roselle/Bloomingdale</u>. Hosted on Tuesday, October 3 at 7:00 p.m. at East Campus, "The Return of Civic Education to Illinois High Schools" will feature the involvement of Lake Park social studies teachers Don Fulmer and Gina Mayo.
