Presentation

Lancers 360° Student Involvement Campaign

Dominic Manola, Assistant Principal for Instructional Innovation and Activities, previewed Lancers 360°, which is a student involvement campaign and action plan for Lake Park. The [presentation](#) addressed objectives, important considerations and next steps with a focus on engaging the student body in three strands: academics; co-curriculars; meaningful relationships and emotional well-being.

Discussion Items

BMW Championship at Medinah Country Club

The Western Golf Association (WGA) has requested use of Lake Park East Campus parking lots during the BMW Championship that will be hosted August 12-18, 2019. Assistant Superintendent for Business Services Jeff O'Connell presented information pertaining to a rental agreement with the WGA for use of parking lots, which are a priority because of the proximity to Medinah Country Club. The rental agreement would include a flat dollar rate for the use of the parking lots and a donation of 25 daily tickets to the event.

2018-19 Student Registration Fees

The recommended student fees for the 2018-19 school year were presented for discussion. The increase is aligned to the December 2016 Consumer Price Index (CPI) of 2.1 percent. ** If approved, the Driver Education Summer School Fee, Summer School Fee, and Summer Bridge Fee increases would take effect for programs offered during 2018 summer school.* Administration recommends an increase for the following:

Action Item

The Board of Education approved a rate increase in the range of hourly rates for legal services provided by Robbins Schwartz. The amount of the monthly retainer remains \$175 and the scope of services covered by the retainer will not change. New rates take effect March 1, 2018.

Superintendent's Report

Dr. Lynn Panega acknowledged the challenging events of Feb. 23 and Feb. 26 that impacted students, families, staff, and the entire school community. In light of the school tragedy in Parkland, FL, emotions understandably are running high.

The administrative team continues to debrief in collaboration with the Roselle Police Department on both of the very different incidents. She commended staff for their response and going 'above and beyond.' Dr. Panega also recognized the RPD and the support they provided.

School safety and security is a joint responsibility. Please continue to emphasize the importance of "If you see or hear something, say something." With the immediacy and publicity of social media, it is critical that all stakeholders bring forward any threats or concerns.

Current safety measures in place include: School Resource Officers, staff training, student training during Safety Week, locked entrances, visitor screening and registration, video surveillance, and interlocking doors to protect vestibules. The District will be conducting an audit of security protocols to explore other measures to enhance security.

Proactive planning is underway with student leaders regarding nationally proposed walkouts on March 14 and April 20. Staff are receiving guidance for safety measures on those dates.
