Discussion Items

School Exec Connect: Superintendent Search Process

Following presentations from three executive search firms between November 2018 and February 2019, Board members contracted with School Exec Connect to conduct a Superintendent Search for replacement effective June 30, 2020. The Board of Education selected this company for their long history of working with high school districts and a shared philosophy to involve stakeholders in this important process.

During the meeting, two representatives from School Exec Connect presented information for discussion about the timeline and process for the Superintendent search that would likely begin in August 2019. Board members still need to make a final determination if the timeline will be completed prior to winter break or if an announcement will be made in January 2020. School Exec Connect provided sample communication for advertising as well as surveying staff and community members in developing a new Superintendent profile.

2018-2019 Budget Amendment

The Fiscal Year 2018-19 budget needs to be amended to reflect budget changes within the Educational Fund and Operations and Maintenance Fund. The Board will vote following a public hearing on the proposed amended budget at the May 20 Board of Education meeting. Once approved, the amended budget will be filed with the Regional Office of Education and the State Board of Education.

Superintendent's Report

Dr. Panega shared highlights about Lake Park curricular opportunities and previewed upcoming student activities.

- The Manufacturing Department hosted the 3rd annual job fair in the West Campus cafeteria on Thursday, April 18 during periods 1-2. All manufacturing students had access to career information, internship opportunities, summer jobs and long-term employment. Students were encouraged to print copies of their resumes and prepare questions for the visiting companies. Special thanks to 17 companies participating!
- Registration is currently open for summer school, boot camps and driver education. Information about the schedule, cost and enrollment process is available on the <u>district website</u>. Boot Camp classes are designed to provide enrichment and a solid foundation in different subject areas. Classes will run depending on enrollment. Civics is being offered for the second year and provides students the opportunity for credit acceleration.
- Performances of *The Wedding Singer*, Lake Park's final theatre production for this school year, will be held in the East Campus Dice Auditorium from Thursday, April 25 through Saturday, April 27 at 7:00 p.m. and Sunday, April 28 at 2:00 p.m.
- Ticket sales to "Gatsby," the 2019 junior and senior prom/post-prom hosted on Saturday, May 18, begin this week on Thursday, April 25. Similar to prior years, prom tickets can be purchased online with a credit/debit card or purchased with cash or check in the West Campus Student Activities Office during school hours through Friday, May 10. The cost per person is \$80 for prom and \$40 for post-prom.
- Lark Park administrators and staff look forward to welcoming parents of the incoming Class of 2023 to the final orientation program this year on Monday, April 29.
