Superintendent Search Timeline

Board President Barb Layer presented a revised timeline (draft) for the Superintendent search with an end goal to complete the selection process by December 2019. Board members discussed availability and made changes to the dates that pertain to their participation. The proposed timeline will be sent to the search firm, School Exec Connect, for final review and scheduling.

Action Items

Approval of the Amended Budget for the 2018-2019 Fiscal Year

Following the public hearing on the amendment to the 2018-2019 budget, Board members voted to approve the budget changes within the Educational Fund and Operations and Maintenance Fund. The amended budget will be filed with both the Regional Office of Education and the Illinois State Board of Education.

Travel Expense Reimbursement

The Board of Education approved travel expense reimbursement to the parents of a District student associated with the parents' and/or student's visits to and from the residential educational placement where the student resides.

- □ Lake Park High School has been named to the U.S. News & World Report 2019 List of Best High Schools, a national designation based on student performance. Schools are ranked on their performance on state-required tests, graduation and how well they prepare students for college. The list ranks Lake Park #69 out of 647 high schools in Illinois, and nationally #1508 out of more than 17,000 schools. This distinction places Lake Park in the elite top tier of high schools. - □ The Class of 2019 celebrated a safe prom this past weekend and will finish the year with Scholarship and Awards Night on May 21 and graduation on May 30 at 7 p.m. at the Sears Centre Arena in Hoffman Estates. May 22 will be the last final full day of school for seniors.
- Lake Park is proud to again be involved in Flags for Roselle, the community-wide project that will kickoff the 3rd annual installation of U.S. flags to 300 subscribers on Memorial Day, May 27. Volunteers will install flags on 18 designated routes throughout Roselle on five holidays including Flag Day, Independence Day, Patriot's Day and Veterans' Day.
- ☐ First semester summer school starts June 10; second semester begins the week of July 8. Students have the opportunity to earn make-up credits due to failure, take classes for credit acceleration, and to build skills in preparation for courses during the school year through a variety of boot camps.
