## Presentation

The Village of Roselle has formally launched a strategic visioning process to develop a shared community vision reflective of stakeholder involvement. They are seeking support and input from governmental agencies including schools, park districts, and libraries from the surrounding communities. To demonstrate a level of commitment, Lake Park presented a joint vision resolution.

## Discussion Items

### Fiscal Year Budget 2019-20

Assistant Superintendent for Business Services Dr. Jeff O'Connell presented a tentative draft of the Fiscal Year 2019-20 budget. The administrative team will continue to monitor year-end activities associated with Fiscal Year 2018-19. The administration will monitor the State of Illinois budget process making changes as necessary, and present the FY20 budget at the September 2019 Board meeting.

### Revision to Board Policies 5.60 and 5:220

Based on recent changes made to Illinois law, revised board policies 5:60—Expenses and 5:220—Substitute Teachers were presented to the Board for first reading and discussion.

### Board Participation on Committees

Due to the appointment of the newest member, the Board discussed participation on District committees.

## Action Items

### Appointment of Principal for 2019-2020

Board members voted unanimously to appoint Dominic Manola as Principal of Lake Park High School, effective July 1, 2019.

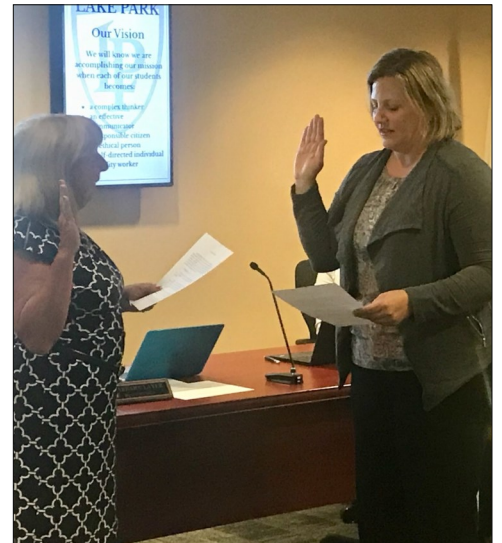
Special thanks to John Gouriotis who completed three years of service in this role and recently requested reassignment as the East Campus Associate Principal.

### Travel Expense Reimbursement

The Board approved travel expense reimbursement to the parents of a District student associated with the parents' and/or student's visits to/from the residential educational placement where the student resides.

## Superintendent's Report

- ❑ Lake Park campuses are active this summer with hundreds of students attending summer school and camps, while teachers are working on curriculum projects. The District hosted a grant collaborative for area districts with ISBE representation as well as a Math Summit with teachers and administrators from sender districts.
- ❑ From July 16-18, the Roselle Fire Department will conduct emergency training for the BMW Championship Tournament. The EC bus lot and circle drive will be used for training from 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. but will remain open and should not impact traffic flow.
- ❑ Culminating two weeks of summer theatre camp, thespians will present *Shrek, Jr.* in a free public performance on July 18 at 7 p.m.
- ❑ Lake Park will participate in a Solar Rebate check presentation with ComEd on July 25 at 9 a.m.
